



CAMP RULES AND OBLIGATIONS

I. OBLIGATIONS OF THE CAMP PARTICIPANT

1. Follow the agenda and camp routines, discipline, and instructions of the camp leaders.
2. Protect your health and do not harm others', immediately alert camp leaders if you notice that one of the participants needs any help.
3. **Try** to speak English throughout the camp.
4. Do not use your mobile phone or tablet during the camp and hand over these devices to camp leaders upon request.
5. **Do not smoke, drink alcohol or use other intoxicants during the camp.**
6. Immediately inform camp leaders of any incident that could damage the good atmosphere of the camp: offenders, self-possession, breaking rules. In our camp, these cases are not overlooked, and we strive to maximize the well-being of each participant, so any negative behavior and lack of cooperation may result in the camper going home prematurely.
7. Do not leave the campsite without the permission of the camp leaders.
8. Pay attention to the lights, do not leave them on unnecessarily, always make sure you turn off the lights after you leave the building.
9. Sleep in your tent at night and do not visit other participants' tents.
10. When you wake up in the morning a bit too early - leave the tent, if you want to talk or make some other noise - move to the chill zone further away from the tent town so that other sleepers can rest without interruption.
11. Maintain order during meals, do not run around food, do not push, try to stand in line and wait in line for your turn.
12. **Do not bully or call other participants abusive names.**
13. Do not feed dogs and do not lift Uma (white dog), she has serious problems with her spine.
14. If you take too much food and can't finish it, don't throw it away, because the dogs will find everything and eat it; throw everything in the nearest bin.
15. **Do not write offensive anonymous letters during letter time.**
16. Use litter bins in toilets and do not put anything in the toilet, including toiletries and toilet paper.
17. In the dark, do not run in the tent town, because there is a high risk of getting caught in the tent ropes and being injured.
18. Do not wash dishes in the shower or throw food waste into the sink.

II. OBLIGATIONS OF THE PARENTS (CARETAKERS)

1. **Come to the camp at the right time (Sunday after 8 PM, Monday before 12 PM). If you arrive early on Sunday, before the camp is open, take a trip to the lake or have a walk to the observation tower. Until 8 PM. you won't be able to sign documents, set up tents, etc.**
2. Submit the completed and signed camp documents to the camp organizer before or at the start of the camp: Camp Participation Agreement and Annexes: 1 Parental Consent, no. 2 Camp Rules and Obligations; familiarize the participant with the Camp Schedule and stuff-to-bring list.
3. Take responsibility if the camp participant you represent would damage the camp organizer's property used during the camp by his or her own guilty acts.
4. Pick up your child from the camp if the child is expelled from the camp early for violations. If you do not pick up the child in person, send a written permission for the participant to be seated in the bus.
5. Do not interfere with the camp program. Do not visit or disturb the children during the camp without a valid reason (children will have time for telephone conversations at the end of the day's program, other times all their devices will be with the camp leaders so please contact them if necessary). Inform the camp leaders of the early arrival. Inform the camp leaders personally when picking up a child temporarily (or before leaving).
